MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.)
Once upon a time, there was a
kingdom that held a dark and
terrible secret.

WORMS EYE VIEW UP AT THE CASTLE WALLS

MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.)
The prince, you see, dearies ...

INT. THE PRINCE'S BEDCHAMBER - MORNING

ON THE PRINCE, FROM BEHIND HIM, and hes sitting up in his bed and hes looking down at his mattress and

WORMS EYE VIEW UP AT HIS WIDE EYED FACE AND

MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.) (CONT'D)
... could not seem to stop wetting
the bed.

THE PRINCE STARTS SOBBING, clasps his palms over his eyes in shame as his tears continue to flow.

INT. THE ROYAL DINING HALL - MORNING

THE KING AND QUEEN, having a discussion with each other and they look very frantic and upset, scowls, eyes rolls, shaking their heads,

MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.)
The king and queen were more than
ashamed ...

and they both turn at the same time to look like they've been caught red handed or something at

THE PRINCE, entering the scene yawning like a young man coming downstairs for breakfast in an average family household.

KING and QUEEN, forced pretend smile at the prince, and then turning away from him to exchange a shaky pretend laugh and glance with each other, as if trying to make their son and each other think everything is fine when they know that it really isn't.

MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.) (CONT'D)
... they were concerned.

THE PRINCE, awkward teenager morning smile at his parents.

MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.) (CONT'D)
Concerned not only for their son,
but also for their kingdom of
course.

THE KING AND QUEEN, awkward smiles still forced themselves.

MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.)
(CONT'D)
For, who could they find to
betroth to this young fool
and make him a king, what
princess could their young
prince take for himself to
bed ... when his bed remains
...

THE PRINCE
Mother, father, it seems that
I have soiled my bedchambers
once more, I ... am sorry, my
dear Mother and Father.

THE PRINCE, awkward look at his parents and stupid chuckle

INT. THE PRINCE'S BEDCHAMBER - MORNING

CLOSE UP ON THE PISS STAINED SPOT ON THE MATTRESS, ZOOMING
IN SLOWLY ON IT.

MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.) (CONT'D)
... soiled.

EXT. LAVISH ROYAL CASTLE - DAY

LOOKING OUT FROM THE COURTYARD AT THE TOWN, PANNING SLOWLY
TO EVENTUALLY FACING THE CASTLE.

MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.) (CONT'D)
And without a future king and
queen, the kingdom would perish.

INT. THRONE ROOM - DAY

ON THE KING, and he raises his head up and smiles as his
eyes widen in a light-bulb going off in his head look sort
of moment, and we watch him turn to THE QUEEN and show her
his big smile, and

MOTHER GOOSE (V.O.)
But one day, the king and queen had
a wonderful idea.

EXT. IN TOWN - DAY

KNIGHTS AND ROYAL GUARDSMEN RIDING AROUND THE TOWN AND

PUTTING UP POSTERS EVERYWHERE THAT READ "**SEEKING WOMEN WITH
BED WETTING PROBLEMS**"

THEY PUT THEM ON THE SIDES OF HOUSES,

TAVERNS, SHOPS,

WELLS AND BARNES,

ON FENCES,

RIGHT ON PEOPLE'S HORSE'S AND CARTS.

Then we see

TOWN'S PEOPLE COMING OUT AND LOOKING AT ALL THE POSTERS AND

WOMEN READING THE POSTERS AND

LAUGHING AT THEM.
