Genre: Sci-Fi, Action, Drama

Similar: Game of Thrones meets Lost in Space.

Logline: From the ashes of the apocalypse three nations have risen to rediscover technology, each other and the hatred that almost destroyed the world generations ago. The fate of the planet rests in the hands of those few who would fight to prevent war.

## SERIES SYNOPSIS

Set in the future after the world has ended in plague, fire and ice. Three nations, called 'Blocks' rise from the ashes to start civilization and technology again.

The Southern Block, forced underground due to surface radiation, has a 'caste' system, where people are assigned a job for life. A ruthless albino priest has seized control and gains political power. The tinkerer, the priest's genius twin brother, has rediscovered how to make energy weapons and other useful items using chemical reaction within crystals. He wants to be left alone. The Senate, a ruling council, would pit one brother against the other in order to gain more power and technology. The Northern Block, models itself after the old west, minus the guns and the Indians. The town blacksmith heads up the research team attempting to rediscover electricity and magnetism, while the town leader tries his best to prevent it.

The Eastern Block, people of Asian descent, are ruled by an all-powerful Emperor. The General, who guards the Great stone wall, he has to deal with monsters and deserters while keeping an eye on the other two emerging cultures.

As each nation deals with its own social and political problems, technology advances. Eventually each nation discovers that they are not alone and that is where the real problems begin.

## SYNOPSIS BY SEASON

## SEASON 1

After the Northern and Southern Blocks discover each other, fear takes over and internal struggles intensify. An arms race develops between the 'Blocks' and the Eastern Block has to spy on both. These spies bring back intel and samples of tech.

# SEASON 2

Barely out of the dark ages, war breaks out. Both Northern and Southern blocks become divided from within as people fight for and against the war. Several characters from both sides die. Technology soon surpasses anything seen today and weapons of mass destruction are created on both sides. To prevent their use, the Eastern Block reveals itself.

# SEASON 3 AND BEYOND

Only a few of the Season 1 characters are still alive and they must use all their resources to stop the war. Both the Northern and Southern Blocks fearing the Eastern Block aligning with the other do everything in their power to prevent it.

#### RECURRING CHARACTER LIST

#### SOUTHERN BLOCK

Demetrius - Albino Priest. Political tyrant in training. Gaius - Tinkerer. Priest's twin brother. The mind behind all of the Southern block's tech and deftly opposed to his brother's rise to power.

Apprentice - Worships the ground Gaius walks on. Calls him Master all the time, which Gaius refutes.

Senators 1-7 - Senate. They elect, advise and dismiss the leader of the block. Their only goal is more power for themselves.

# NORTHERN BLOCK

Jason - Apprentice blacksmith who worships his mentor Mark. Lisa - Jason's girlfriend. She's smarter than she lets on. Mark Mason - Charismatic. Master blacksmith, relic hunter and brilliant scientist.

Thomas Worth - Council Elder. He has a strong dislike of Mark and an unknown reason for preventing the advancement of any and all technology.

## EASTERN BLOCK

Ursin-Kun - General who rules by "tough love".

Orin-Re - Chief Advisor and political genius. Overly ambitious.

Rebel - First and only survivor of an attack by "The Beast".

Healer - Older woman who knows more about plants and natural medicine than anyone on the planet.

Wolf-hound - A dog and wolf cross breed. Often captured and trained for use by the Eastern Block elite soldiers.

The Beast - Highly evolved cousin of the Panda. A mutant resembling more werewolf than bear. Solitary, territorial, cunning and very aggressive. Actually, there are more than one.
