LOUISE (nervous) You don't have to do this.

Louise groans gently.

TOM You're the sort of woman who needs this sort of release. - you deserve pleasure from time to time.

LOUISE (GROANS) OH, MY GOD!

Her body throbs as her body absorbs the pleasure.

TOM You're free now.

They passionate kiss each other. Tom squeezes her more sensually. Louise looses her underwear partly visible.

LOUISE you're right, running that place sheckles me to it. always things to clean and tidy.

she turns to Tom with a warm glint in her eye. she closes her eyes wanting to remember.
