FADE IN

INT. BEDROOM-MORNING

The sound of 90's R&B music is playing in the background. REGINA YOUNG, 50's, attractive, spunky, articulate, dressed in a business attire pantsuit gets ready for a job interview. Putting on her lip gloss, she finally cuts off her clock radio, grabs her car keys and heads out.

INT./EXT. SUV-MORNING

In her black SUV, Regina drives down the street. Windows down, she observes kids stepping onto a school bus. A typical weekday that only makes her wish it was Saturday already.

A car with a couple of handsome men pull up next to her at a light. One of the guys gives Regina a smile. Regina notices the shiny rims on the car and shakes her head.

REGINA (V.O.) I know those rims are as hot as a bag of flamin hot Cheetos.

The men gave Regina the peace sign and drive off.

INT./EXT.SUV-ESTABLISHING

Regina continues driving down the street. Then a call comes in on cellphone connected to her car speaker. She presses the button.

> REGINA (On Phone) Hello?

MAYA (O.S.) Hey Regina.

MAYA SINGLETON, 40's, her face isn't shown yet, generous, street smart with a heart of gold.

REGINA I'll be there in 10 minutes.

MAYA That's not why I was calling.

REGINA

Then what?

MAYA I need a favor from you.

REGINA Uh oh what is it this time?

MAYA

C'mon now you owe me something after I hooked you up with this interview.

REGINA (Eyeroll) Fine, what?

MAYA

Do you know where I can find a house or apartment?

REGINA Have you checked on 15th Avenue? I heard they're taking new tenants.

MAYA Regina? Who in their right mind gonna stay in an area where you got a pimp running a duplex?

REGINA A pimp ain't running no duplex?

MAYA You ain't seen the news neither.

REGINA What you talking about?

MAYA

The pimp got arrested for fraud because he was ripping off his tenants.

REGINA (Sighing) Pookie got in trouble again?-

MAYA

Exactly.

REGINA Girl bye, I'll see what I can do. She turns off the speaker phone.

INT./EXT. ADMINISTRATOR'S OFFICE-MOMENTS LATER

Regina stop outside the administration's office. She's hesitant to enter but she needed the job. As she look at her phone, an older man approaches her.

OLDER MAN Need any help ma'am?

REGINA (Looking up) Oh I'm...I'm looking for this.

She shows him a slip of paper.

OLDER MAN You're in the right place, just go on inside.

> REGINA You work here?

OLDER MAN You can say that.

REGINA Oh you're a professor?

OLDER MAN If I was I certainly wouldn't be here talking to you.

He winks causing Regina to laugh. He opens and holds the door for her.

REGINA

Thank you.

Regina enters. She sees her dear friend Maya Singleton typing on the computer. Maya is an administrative assistant at the college.

Regina clears her throat to get her attention. No response. She does it again. Again nothing.

REGINA (CONT'D) You still want me to find a house for you?

Maya finally shot her a look then Regina starts laughing.

MAYA Girl stop.

REGINA (Hugging her) How do I look?

MAYA (Eyeing her up and down) Well...At least you won't work in the Cafeteria-

> REGINA Oh shut up.

MAYA You could go in now.

> REGINA Thanks.

INT. CARL'S OFFICE-SECONDS LATER

Regina opens the door to see CARL ANDERSON, handsome, likeable, and a classy guy in his mid 50's. He looks up at Regina standing in his office.

He stands up and walk around to greet her.

CARL (Extending his hand) You must be Regina Young.

> REGINA (Smiling) I am.

CARL I'm Carl Anderson, head of the legal department.

REGINA Pleasure to meet you.

> CARL Have a seat.

They both sit down.

CARL (CONT'D) So tell me a little about yourself.

REGINA

(Awkward)

I was referred to this position by Maya Singleton, who's a dear friend of mine. I have a law degree from Howard University and an Undergrad from UCLA.

CARL

I see there's a 2 year gap on your resume. We're you looking for employment?

REGINA Yes. This is the first office I been in that actually smells good.

Carl stares at her, bewildered.

INT./EXT. ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICE-SAME

Maya is typing on the computer when JAMIE COX, 20's enters. He carries himself with a calm and swag manner while trying unsuccessfully to hide his issues with selfishness.

> JAMIE Yo Maya can I holla at you?

MAYA

(Eyerolling him) That's Ms. Singleton to you Jamie. Now what you want?

JAMIE My bad, my bad Ms. Singleton. I was wondering if I can switch my litigation class.

MAYA

Uh Jamie? You know you need that course to graduate.

JAMIE

C'mon Ms. Singleton I'm not even interested in suing people as a practice. I rather do corporate law, slide and shine with the big wigs ya dig?

MAYA

(Unfazed) Jamie you gonna face a cold world out there. (MORE) MAYA (CONT'D) If I were you I'll think about other options before you end up at Burger King.

JAMIE I did that before-

MAYA

Oh please.

JAMIE Fine. Mr. Anderson in his office?

MAYA Yeah he's interviewing somebody.

> JAMIE For real, who?

MAYA None of your business.

EXT. CARL'S OFFICE-SECONDS LATER

Regina comes out with Carl laughing as though they were old friends. They then spot Jamie and Maya who couldn't help but notice their behavior.

CARL Anyway, nice meeting you Ms. Young.

REGINA You too Mr. Anderson.

CARL I'll give you my decision tomorrow morning.

> REGINA Okay, thank you.

He steps back inside just as Jamie rushes to talk to him.

JAMIE

Yo Mr. Anderson wait up!

Regina walk towards Maya.

REGINA Who that was? MAYA Oh girl that's Jamie Cox, first year freshman. He call himself saying he wanted to be a corporate lawyer.

REGINA Okay what's wrong with that?

MAYA He wanna switch his litigation class. He won't e able to graduate unless he take that course.

Regina gives her the eyeroll.

MAYA (CONT'D) Anyway, how did it go?

REGINA It went well, surprised about that.

MAYA Why? I know you got a hell of a resume.

INT. CARL'S OFFICE-SAME

Jamie exits.

ACT TWO.

FADE IN

INT. LIVING ROOM-LATE AFTERNOON

Regina enters her living room in her small but modest apartment. She places her purse on the couch, takes off her jacket and hangs it in the closet. She then hears a knock at the door.

She opens to find the mailman waiting outside.

REGINA Yes?

MAILMAN Special delivery for you Ms. Young.

He hands her an envelope.

REGINA Thank you. Mailman eyes her as though he's expecting a tip. She glances back at him annoyed.

REGINA (CONT'D) If you want a tip I'll give you one. Don't drink the water if you ever go to Mexico, goodbye sweetheart.

Regina closes the door. Her eyes remain set on the envelope with a look of dismay on her face. She places the envelop on her kitchen countertop along with several other pieces of mail.

Regina's home phone rings. She puts it on speaker.

REGINA (CONT'D) (On Speaker) Hello?

MAYA Hey girl...Come to the door.

Regina walks towards the door. She opens and sees Maya smiling.

REGINA What you stalking me now?

MAYA Girl I ain't studyin you.

She enters. Regina cuts off the speaker then closes the door.

REGINA What's up?

MAYA I found a place.

REGINA For real, where?

MAYA Its not too far from here to tell you the truth.

Regina shoots her an "What have you done" look.

REGINA Maya?

MAYA Across the hall ain't that far. They embrace in a bear hug.

REGINA (CONT'D) What room do you have?

MAYA I just leased Room 209.

REGINA Oh yeah. That was Tee Tee's apartment.

MAYA Who the hell was that?

REGINA Child you don't wanna know. You want something? Wine? Champagne? Lets celebrate.

MAYA Hell nah Regina you know I don't drink.

REGINA Girl since when did you not drink?

MAYA Since last year.

> REGINA Last year?

MAYA For health reasons I quit drinking.

Maya sits on the couch. Regina joins her.

REGINA Maya, what's going on with you? We girls you can tell me anything.

MAYA Several months ago I started having seizures. I didn't know where it came from in the beginning until I drank alcohol.

Not knowing what to say, Regina stands up continuing to stare at her.

REGINA Maya? You mean to tell me you have Epilepsy?

MAYA You figured that out all by yourself?

Regina chuckles a bit.

REGINA You can have some milk instead.

MAYA Hey, I already got Epilepsy I don't need Gas too.

Regina shakes her head.

REGINA Alright how about some Cranberry Juice?

MAYA Cool, at least it'll keep my bladder dancing.

INT. LIVING ROOM-AN HOUR LATER

Regina is visibly disappointed. She folds up the letter and slips it back inside.

EXT. NEIGHBORHOOD-EARLY EVENING

Jamie and his friend ASHE RAYBURN, Mid 20's, smooth talking, love to start trouble, walk home from the movies.

JAMIE Look I don't know about her okay? She wears big glasses and braces on her teeth.

ASHE Then who you got in mind? JAMIE I saw a woman at the school today applying for a job there, she fine as hell.

ASHE Yeah and I bet she old enough to be your mama.

JAMIE So. I like older women.

Suddenly out of nowhere a police car crosses in front, stopping them.

An officer climbs out with a gun drawn.

OFFICER 1 Hands in the air!

Their hands slowly raise up.

ASHE

What's going on Officer?

Another Officer steps out.

OFFICER 1 What are you two doing in this neighborhood?

JAMIE We're going home. You know something ya'll shoulda been doing-

> OFFICER 2 Shut up!

OFFICER 1 (To his partner) Search them.

Jamie and Ashe nervously eye each other as the Officer pat them up and down.

ASHE (Mumbling) Can't believe this.

Officer 2 finds nothing.

OFFICER 2 They're clean. OFFICER 1 You're free to go, stay out of trouble.

Jamie and Ashe finally lower their hands. The officers get back in the police car and drives off.

ASHE (Shooting Jamie a look) What the hell just happened?

Jamie shakes his head.

ACT THREE

INT. BEDROOM-EARLY MORNING

Regina comes out of her bedroom wearing a robe when her phone rings.

She glances at it and presses the talk button.

REGINA (On phone) Hello.

CARL Ms. Young? This is Carl Anderson.

REGINA Oh hello Mr. Anderson, how are you doing?

CARL I'm doing fine. I called to tell you that I looked over your qualifications and I believe you will be an excellent addition to our faculty.

REGINA Are you saying I got the job?

CARL Yes Ms. Young, you got the job.

REGINA (Relieved) Oh thank you Mr. Anderson, thank you. When can I start? You can officially start teaching tomorrow. You'll be teaching Constitutional Law and Civil Litigation, both taught in the morning. You'll need to come down today and fill out some paperwork to start the process.

REGINA What time can I come in?

CARL Would 11:00am work?

REGINA I'll be there. Thanks again.

CARL You're welcome...See you soon.

> REGINA You too.

She hangs up and started jumping up and down cheering for joy over the good news.

REGINA (CONT'D) (Calming down) Whoooo.

INT. ADMINISTRATION OFFICE-MORNING

> MAYA Uh--Uh hold on. What's going on?

GUARD Are you in charge?

MAYA No I'm the Administrative Assistant. The department head is inside, what--

Guard brushes past Maya and knocks on the door.

CARL (O.S.) Come in. INT. CARL'S OFFICE-CONTINOUS

Guard and Jamie enters. Carl studies the few bruises on Jamie's face and abruptly stands.

CARL (Outraged) What is going on here?

GUARD I caught this kid fighting another guy a few blocks down the street. He told me to bring him here instead of a police station out of fear of being in serious trouble.

CARL (Firmly) Its okay, I'll handle this.

GUARD

Thank you.

Guard exits. Carl shrugs his hands in the air in frustration at Jamie.

CARL What the hell are you doing fighting?

JAMIE Some fool was talking about my mom Mr. Anderson. I can't let that slide.

INT. ADMINISTRATION OFFICE-SAME

Regina enters with a big grin on her face, making Maya take notice of the news.

MAYA You got the job didn't you?

REGINA Was Ray Charles blind?

> MAYA Girl, come here.

They embrace in a hug. Then they hear loud commotion coming from Carl's office.

INT. CARL'S OFFICE-SAME

Jamie and Carl continue arguing about Jamie's fighting and recent troublemaking behavior.

CARL You keep doing these things and I won't be able to help you next time.

JAMIE

(Frustrated) Help? When the hell did I need help Mr. Anderson? I can take care of my damn self.

CARL Well you're not doing a good job of that so far. Between taking care of your mom, working part-time, and class, you're falling off your

A beat. Carl sits in front of him.

feet.

CARL (CONT'D) You gotta think about your future Jamie. What do you want to do with your life? You said you wanted to be a corporate lawyer.

JAMIE

I did. But now I don't know anymore. For a while now I was wondering why I'm in college in the first place. Is it because I want to or am I doing it because I'm following my mom's footsteps?

Jamie gets up in anger.

CARL You'll have a new professor tomorrow.

> JAMIE (Sarcastic) Whoopie. Who is it?

CARL You'll find out tomorrow.

Jamie starts to exit when Carl calls out to him.

CARL (CONT'D) Jamie?

JAMIE What?

CARL

I'm not gonna suspend you but if you ever do something like that again, lets just say next time you won't be so lucky.

From Carl's expression, Jamie knows he has to get himself together and nods as a way of saying he understood.

CARL (CONT'D) Go home Jamie. I'll see you tomorrow.

Jamie exits.

EXT. ADMINISTRATION OFFICE-SAME

Regina and Maya are talking outside the hallway.

REGINA So he'll be in my class?

MAYA Yeah. You teaching Civil Litigation remember?

REGINA Hmm. This should be interesting.

Jamie comes out eyeing them up and down flirting, smiling then walks off.

Maya starts chuckling at Regina. Regina gives her an "Oh shut up" wave.

MAYA You wanna go to lunch after you see Carl?

REGINA Yeah long as the food good. MAYA

Stick with me, I'll hook you up.

REGINA Girl you done hooked me up so many times I'm turning into an escort service.

Regina steps inside.

INT. CARL'S OFFICE-SECONDS LATER

Carl scans an old photo of his mother from his childhood. A knock on the door snaps him out of his daze.

CARL (Putting the picture away and sits in his chair) Come in.

Regina enters.

REGINA Am I early?

CARL Actually you're right on time.

Regina sits in front of him while he hands over the school documents.

She studies how thick the packet is.

REGINA Interesting way to start the day.

CARL Trust me it won't take too long.

Regina grabs a pen and starts signing papers.

INT. ADMINISTRATION OFFICE-SAME

Maya steps back inside with a cup of coffee in hand. She takes a sip. Phone rings almost causing her to drop her cup.

MAYA (Mumbling) Damn it.

She answers.

MAYA (CONT'D) (Into Phone) Stedman University, Maya Singleton speaking....Who this is?...What the hell you doing call me here?...No but you gonna get my ass in trouble fool....I'm not bailing you out...Yeah we tight but you called me at work...Boy please...Look I'll call you later but you gotta get your ass off the line, I'm dead ass serious...peace.

She hangs up, sighs, and holds her head in her hands.

END OF ACT TWO

ACT THREE

INT. ADMINISTRATION OFFICE-HALF HOUR LATER

Maya is typing on her laptop when Carl's office door opens and Regina is outside with Carl.

Maya's expression tells her that things must've went smoothly.

INT./EXT CARL'S OFFICE-SAME

Regina stands outside with Carl standing in the doorway.

REGINA I'm really anxious to start teaching tomorrow.

CARL You'll get your chance.

REGINA

What is up with that kid me and Maya saw earlier? I think his name is Jamie..

CARL Jamie Cox? He's in one of your classes. Civil Litigation. He's not a bad kid but he just has a lot of hang ups, you know?

> REGINA Don't we all?

A slight awkwardness stands between them as Maya looks on. After a short pause, Regina begins to walk away.

> CARL See you tomorrow.

REGINA (Turning to Carl) You too.

Carl exits back into his office and closes the door.

Maya gives Regina a devious smile.

REGINA (CONT'D) What?

MAYA (Shaking her head grinning) You got the hots for him already I see.

REGINA You act like I'm auditioning for a sequel to The Boy Next Door.

MAYA Well...now that you mentioned it--

> REGINA Shut up Maya.

MAYA (Grabbing her purse) We gonna get something to eat or what?

REGINA Lead the way Moms Mabley.

MAYA Girl don't play with me.

They exit.

INT. CAFETERIA-AFTERNOON

Regina and Maya are eating lunch in the Cafeteria. Maya is stuffing her face like hasn't done it in years. Regina is slowly eating her salad. Maya rolls her eyes while ignoring her. She slows down then drinks some soda.

MAYA Pookie called me earlier.

> REGINA (Surprised) For real?

> > MAYA Yeah.

REGINA Did he call your cell number?

MAYA No he called on the school line.

REGINA Why the hell he did that?

MAYA He want me to bail his ass out. Ain't no way in hell I'm doing that.

REGINA But ya'll tight as hell and you won't hook him up?

MAYA Hell nah. He put himself in that mess, he need to wake up and smell the coffee before his ass get hit by a sugar truck.

Regina is confused by the analogy but gets the sentiment.

REGINA I don't know what that means but you're right.

Regina looks at the time on her phone then puts it down.

REGINA (CONT'D) I got a letter from the California Bar.

MAYA Really? What did it say? REGINA You don't wanna know.

MAYA Oh. The way you sound it could be what I think it is.

REGINA I rather not talk about it. I just hope in time things will change.

MAYA It will, keep trying.

EXT. BASKETBALL COURT-AFTERNOON

Jamie and Ashe are playing basketball to let off steam from last night's incident.

Ashe drives to the hole to lay the ball in, Jamie swipes it out of bounds.

JAMIE Weak ass move bruh.

ASHE What you mean? You fouled the hell outta me.

JAMIE That was all ball man, quit actin soft--

ASHE No wonder your ass got kicked off the basketball team in high school, couldn't handle the pressure.

JAMIE

You wanna go there with me? Really? How about you Ashe? Why you failed 9th grade twice?

ASHE

You know damn well why that happened fool? I was stupid just like you were when you got kicked off the team. We even or what?

Realizing what they're doing, they stopped arguing.

JAMIE Look at us man. We fussing over stupid stuff, let alone the past.

> ASHE Cool?

JAMIE

Cool.

They dap each other as a way of making up.

ASHE Need a ride home?

JAMIE Might as well. I don't feel like running into those fool ass cops again.

Ashe laughs hard and they exit to Ashe's car.

INT. HALLWAY-LATE AFTERNOON

Regina and Maya walk down the hallway of their apartment building.

MAYA What a day this was.

REGINA

You got that right. Me starting a new job, you stuffing your face, me dealing with a bunch of college kids tomorrow, Pookie staying in jail. What could possibly top that?

MAYA You hooking up with Carl.

REGINA

Don't start.

MAYA

C'mon I saw the way you two were looking at each other, skinnin' and grinnin' all over the place. Can't tell me something wasn't up.

REGINA Maya why you trippin? Ain't nothing going on between me and Carl. (MORE)

REGINA (CONT'D)

I can't say the same for you and Pookie though--

MAYA

Uh-Uh hell nah Regina, you don't get to flip the script on me that easy.

REGINA And how long ya'll been friends?

MAYA Since high school but--

REGINA

Well there you go.

MAYA

Honey listen. I'll always be there for him but I'm tired of cleaning up his messes all the time, that's why he never owns up to what he do. To be honest I would put you in that category.

Regina gives her the "don't go there" look.

REGINA

Excuse me?

MAYA

Yeah I said it G. You used to pull the same foolishness as Pookie except you sneaky with yours, almost to a point nobody can catch you. But I know you too well, trouble usually follows everywhere you go.

REGINA

(Brushing her off) Thank you for the lecture Ms. Oprah. Now can I go to my apartment or do I have to ask permission from you?

MAYA Why? Did I hit a nerve?--

REGINA Bye Maya!

Regina sprints away from Maya.

INT. BEDROOM-EARLY EVENING

After eating dinner, Regina is in her bedroom sitting at her dresser drinking a glass of red wine and staring at the envelope she received from The California Bar.

She picks up the phone and makes a call.

REGINA

(On phone) Hey its me...You busy?....No I just got back home...Yeah I found a job at a college teaching...I'm serious!...You don't believe me?....Why do you have to bring that up?....Yeah and?....I deserve a second chance just like anybody else in this damn country. (Takes another sip of wine) For real?....Unfortunately it isn't good news but I'm gonna keep trying....Okay....Okay tell her I love her...Bye.

She hangs up.

Regina then hears echoes of Maya's voice from earlier.

MAYA (V.O.) Honey I know you too well. Trouble usually follows you everywhere you go...

Loud music snaps Regina out of her thoughts.

REGINA (Mumbling) Damn they stay playing loud ass music.

Regina gets up and heads towards the front door.

INT./EXT FRONT DOOR-SAME

Regina cracks open the door and sees a couple of young people out in the hallway acting drunk.

MAN (Slurring) C'mon let me drive you home-- WOMAN

You out your damn mind, you trying to get both of us in trouble and shi--

Regina calls out to them.

REGINA Hey can ya'll keep it down out here please?

They look at Regina like she was crazy and stumble away. She closes her door back.

INT. LIVING ROOM-SECONDS LATER

Regina was about to take a shower when she gets a text message from Maya.

MAYA (Text Message) Was that you yelling like a fool outside?

Regina texts Maya back.

REGINA (Text Message) No but a couple of drunks were. I just tried to calm them down.

> MAYA (Text Message) LOL!

Regina puts her cellphone on the countertop and heads to the bathroom to take a shower.

INT. MAYA'S BEDROOM-EVENING

Maya is laying on her bed after taking her medication. She glances at her cellphone. She sees a picture of a small kid and has a flashback.

EXT. PLAYGROUND-FLASHBACK

Maya is playing with a small kid on the swing set. She watches as other children play jump rope, hop scotch, and basketball.

MAYA

Her eyes avert to a black car coming slowly down the street. She gets a sick feeling in the pit of her stomach as though something was about to go down.

BLACK CAR

Back window comes down revealing a man with sunglasses on. He pulls out a gun and points it in Maya's direction.

MAYA

She stares back at the car. Closes her eyes and hears the gun go off. BOOM!

INT. MAYA'S BEDROOM-PRESENT

A knock on the door snaps Maya out of her flashback. She get up off the bed and exits towards the front.

INT. MAYA'S LIVING ROOM-SAME

Maya opens the door to find Jamie at her door. Stunned, she pulls him inside and closes the door behind her.

MAYA What the hell you doing here?

JAMIE Sorry to bother you Ms. Singleton, but I need a favor from you--

MAYA How did you find my apartment?

> JAMIE (Shrugging) Google?

Maya has her hands on her hips, pissed off.

MAYA You looked in my file didn't you?

JAMIE Hell nah. That wasn't me, probably your friend did--

MAYA Uh-uh Jamie don't play games with me. Only your trifling ass would do something like that. You invaded my privacy. JAMIE (Apologetic) I'm sorry, but I'm desperate here!

MAYA What the hell you want Jamie?

Jamie paces around Maya then stops in front of her.

JAMIE I need some money.

MAYA Don't you work?

JAMIE This is an emergency.

> MAYA What is it?

JAMIE

My mom is having an operation in the morning. She has insurance but there's still some things that are not covered and she has to pay out of pocket.

MAYA

Um...how much?

Jamie steps closer to Maya and whispers the amount in her ear.

MAYA (CONT'D) (Pushing Jamie) Are you crazy? I wish I can help you but even I don't have that kind of money.

A short beat.

MAYA (CONT'D) You never did tell me what was wrong with your mom.

JAMIE

Well Mr. Anderson knows what's wrong with her. Lets just leave it at that.

MAYA (Takes out her cellphone) Let me call Regina and ask her if she got any money--JAMIE (Shushing her) Don't do that! --MAYA Why? JAMIE This is between me, you, and Mr. Anderson. MAYA Have you asked Mr. Anderson for money? JAMIE I did but all he gave me was \$200 which is nowhere near enough. MAYA That means you \$800 in the hole. JAMIE (Frustrated) Damn it! MAYA I may know how I can get you some money, but you may not like it. Could I give it to you after your mom get the operation? JAMIE Of course. You got my number right? MAYA Its in the school database Jamie, of course I got your number. JAMIE Alright. I'll call you in the morning.

Jamie starts to exit when Maya calls out to him.

MAYA Jamie? For what its worth I hope your mom feel better.

JAMIE (Smiling) Thanks.

Jamie exits.

INT./EXT. HALLWAY-EVENING

Jamie exits Maya's apartment. She watches him leave then spots Regina peeping at her.

REGINA

Stares at Maya then comes out the door, began walking towards her.

INT./EXT. HALLWAY-SAME

Maya steps out of her apartment. Regina stops in front of her.

REGINA (Stunned) I must've been seeing things all night. Was that Jamie I saw leaving your apartment?

MAYA (Unfazed) Yeah? Is that a crime?

Regina becomes suspicious.

REGINA Maya? What's going on?

MAYA Nothing, he just wanted to ask me for a favor.

REGINA A favor? Like what?

MAYA Nah honey. He told me not to tell anyone. Its between me and him.

REGINA Please tell me you didn't sleep with him?-- MAYA Shut it up Regina!

REGINA Then what is it?

MAYA

Listen. We girls but this is something I have to keep to myself okay? You keep secrets all the time so why can't I?

Maya's last question struck a nerve with Regina.

Maya then re-enters her apartment leaving Regina's face dumbfounded.
